The draft is just around the corner – so sharpen your skates and be sure your child's equipment still fits!

Below is the skating schedule for the upcoming draft skate. Remember that your skater needs to be ready to skate at his/her appropriate time frame to be drafted onto a team. Your child should be at the rink and checked-in **at least** 30 minutes before their scheduled ice time. ***PLEASE NOTE – Check-in will close 10 minutes before the skate starting time so that appropriate paperwork can be completed. Also, a mandatory parent meeting will be held during the draft skate – please plan on attending.**

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

**You must be dressed in FULL HOCKEY GEAR (including mouth guard and neck guard) or you will NOT be eligible to skate. If you normally skate as a goalie, you must skate as a goalie at the draft. Check in will be located in the lobby of Rink C and you will be provided with an identification number and directed to the assigned locker room. The draft will last approximately 50 minutes. This ice time will allow the coaches the opportunity to evaluate and rate each skater before choosing their teams. You will be contacted within 72 hours of the draft with information regarding your team's practice schedule and other pertinent information. PLEASE NOTE: The fall hockey season begins September 8th, 2009. Also, if you will not be at the draft due to illness or other unforeseen reason, you must contact us BEFORE the draft. We have kids on wait list in almost every division who will be drafted in your place, if we do not hear from you. Finally, all special requests for team assignment must be made in writing prior to the actual draft.*
